Sometimes, 14 days isn't enough time to find the bad apples.

Fraud, waste and abuse are growing problems, and small pharmacies can be especially vulnerable to increasingly sophisticated and aggressive pharmacy-fraud tactics. Part D plans help fight fraud using state-of-the-art techniques to detect suspicious billing patterns, monitor pharmacy claims and perform audits.

And a 2007 drugstore lobby study confirms that third party claims (including Part D) are already being paid within 30 days. Forcing Part D plans to pay pharmacies twice as fast as doctors and hospitals would only make fraud, waste and abuse tougher to fight.
